LOCAL AND INTERNATIONAL MISSIONS

First Presbyterian Outreach dollars support the organizations listed below. Volunteers from the committee and the congregation serve the organizations by offering their time, their resources and their prayers.

LOCAL

AMERICA'S YOUTH

A program for disadvantaged children at risk in our community is supported by local churches. Volunteers participate by helping with homework, reading stories, gardening and Bible study.

BARNABAS CENTER, INC.

The nonprofit organization assists residents of Nassau County in crisis by providing food and subsidies for rent and utilities. Medical, dental and counseling services are also available.

COUNCIL ON AGING

The agency provides comprehensive support for Nassau County seniors through five programs: Meals on Wheels, Transportation, Home Health, Senior Life Centers, and Adult Day Health Care.

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

Locally, the mission is to eliminate substandard housing in Nassau County. Volunteers help in the building of new homes. A study bible is given to each homeowner at the dedication.

SOUP TRAIN

The goal is to feed "at risk" homebound seniors who are in dire financial straits and suffer from multiple medical conditions that make buying and preparing meals difficult.

GLOBAL

CHRISTIAN LIGHT SCHOOL, HAITI

The vision from God has remained constant: to impact the lives of children in Haiti through a Christ centered education – one meal, one education, one soul at a time.

HEARTS AND HANDS ACROSS THE SEA

Funds support Jamaica Ecumenical Mutual Mission, with St. Augustine Presbytery, focusing on housing, medical and dental care. Adult and youth exchanges are regularly scheduled.

LA GONÂVE HAITI PARTNERS, TROU JACQUES

The partnership focuses on education for children and adults, preventive healthcare and nutrition, water and agriculture, and economic development for the community of Trou Jacques.
